CAF's mission is to end exploitation in property services and improve work standards. CAF does this by supporting sustainably priced and quality cleaning services, ensuring compliance with workplace laws and regulations, engaging workers and contractors, fostering accountability and transparency in cleaning supply chains and recognising stakeholders who have implemented best practice standards.

The lynchpin to our success lies in the [CAF Building Certification Scheme](#) - a unique social compliance rating tool. CAF works with cleaners, cleaning contractors, building managers, owners and tenants to implement the [CAF Standard](#) at a particular building.
